

A Simple Messianic *Erev Shabbat* Liturgy

Lighting the Sabbath Candles

***Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu, melech ha-olam
Asher hatzdakeinu al y'dey emunah b'Yeshua hamashiach or ha-olam
u'v'shemo anu madlikim haner shel shabbat***

Blessed are You, O Lord our God, King of the universe
Who has justified us through faith in Yeshua the Messiah, the Light of the world
and in his name we kindle the Sabbath lights.

Blessing Over Wine

***Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu, melech ha-olam
Boree pri hagafen***

Blessed are You, O Lord our God, King of the universe
Creator of the fruit of the vine.

Blessing Over Bread

***Baruch atah Adonai Eloheinu, melech ha-olam
Hamotzi lechem min ha-aretz***

Blessed are You, O Lord our God, King of the universe
Who brings forth bread from the earth.

If you are not continuing with the Sabbath Liturgy, you may wish to say The Blessing of the Messiah and the Shema at this time.

Aaronic Benediction

***Y'varech'cha Adonai v'yishmerecha.
Ya'er Adonai panav eleicha vichunekka.
Yissa Adonai panav eleicha v'yasem l'cha shalom.***

The Lord bless you and keep you.
The Lord make his face shine upon you and be gracious to you.
The Lord lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace.
