## \* Notes on Special Haftarah Readings

Bereshit – this reading is for the Jewish observance of Erev Rosh Chodesh 1. The regular reading would have been Isaiah 42:5-43:10.

Vayeshev – this reading is for the Sabbath on the second day of Hanukkah. The regular reading would have been Amos 2:6-3:8.

Mishpatim – this reading is for the Jewish observance of Rosh Chodesh. The regular reading would have been Jeremiah 34:8-22, 33:25-26.

Vayachel – this reading is for the Jewish observance of Shabbat Shekalim. The regular reading would have been 1 Kings 7:40-50.

Vayikra – this reading is for the Jewish observance of Shabbat Zachor. The regular reading would have been Isaiah 43:21-44:23.

Tzav – this reading is for the Jewish observance of Shabbat Parah. The regular reading would have been Jeremiah 7:21-8:3, 9:22(23)-23(24).

Shemini – this reading is for the Jewish observance of Shabbat HaChodesh. The regular reading would have been 2 Samuel 6:1-7:17.

Metzora – this reading is for the Jewish observance of Shabbat HaGadol. The regular reading would have been 2 Kings 7:3-20.

Korach – this reading is for the Jewish observance of Rosh Chodesh. The regular reading would have been 1 Samuel 11:14-12:22.

Mattot and Massei – there is one Haftarah reading for both when these portions are combined after 17 Tamuz.

Ki Tetze – the Messianic haftarah reading of Isaiah 53, the Suffering Servant, Yeshua, is included here.

Netzavim and Vayelech – there is one Haftarah reading for both when these portions are combined.

Ha'azinu – this reading is for when Ha'azinu is before Yom Kippur. The regular reading would have been 2 Samuel 22:1-51.
