Vayachel and Pekudei– this combined special reading is for the Jewish observance of Shabbat HaChodesh.

Ki Tisa – this special reading is for the Jewish observance of Shabbat HaChodesh.

Tzav – this special reading is for the Jewish observance of Shabbat HaGadol.

Tazria and Metzora – this combined special reading is for the Jewish observance of Shabbat Rosh Chodesh.

Acharei Mot and Kedoshim – there is one Haftarah reading for both when these portions are combined.

Chukat and Balak – there is one Haftarah reading for both when these portions are combined.

Behar and Bechukotai – there is one Haftarah reading for both when these portions are combined.

Bamidbar - this special reading is for the Jewish observance of Shabbat Machar Chodesh.

Mattot and Massei – there is one Haftarah reading for both when these portions are combined after 17 Tamuz.

Ki Tetze – the Messianic haftarah reading of Isaiah 53, the Suffering Servant, Yeshua, is included here.

Nitsavim and Vayelech – there is one Haftarah reading for both when these portions are combined.

Ha'azinu – this reading is for when the Jewish observance of Shabbat Shuva.
